CollegeBoard's EFC Calculator https://bigfuture.college board.org/pay-for-college/paying- your-share/expected-family- contribution-calculator	 ★ Estimate your family's Expected Family Contribution (EFC), which is the minimum amount your family will be asked to pay for college for one year ★ Preview questions asked on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) 	 ★ Knowing this number, what can we do now to start preparing for college costs? (Some ideas: apply for outside scholarships, consider getting a summer job, start saving – every little bit counts!) ★ Would we be willing to borrow loans to help cover the cost of college?
Net Price Calculator (NPC) Find on all college websites or search for a school here: http://collegecost.ed.gov/netprice center.aspx	 ★ Estimate how much financial aid you might receive at a specific college or university ★ Estimate your "net price" (the amount your family would have to pay or borrow) for one year at that school 	 ★ Is this school "in or out of the ballpark" for my family financially? ★ Could this be a financial safety option for my college list? ★ What can I do to potentially get more financial aid at this school? (Tip: working hard in AND out of school can increase your eligibility for scholarships.) ★ How does this school compare to others on my list?
College Scorecard https://collegescorecard.ed.gov/	 ★ Learn how a school compares to similar schools on multiple measures, including average annual cost, typical total debt, graduation rate, loan default rate and median borrowing ★ Find information about a school's study body, test scores and academic programs 	 ★ What is the average annual cost for families whose income is similar to ours? (Remember, your actual annual cost may be different.) ★ Are the graduation and retention rates high or low compared to similar schools? ★ How much do students typically owe in federal loans after they graduate?
