### Schools with Policies to Eliminate Loans from Full Need Packages:

- ★ Two asterisks (\*\*) indicates a school that meets full need and will not include any loans in the students’ financial aid package, no matter what their income is.
- ★ One asterisk (\*) indicates a school that meets full need and will not include any loans for a student whose family makes below a certain amount annually (amount indicated in parenthesis), usually assuming typical assets for that income level.

Note: This list may not be fully inclusive. These policies also often come with stipulations, such as specifications of a family’s assets or a student’s dependency status, so always be sure to contact the college/university directly to find out if a student is eligible.
