

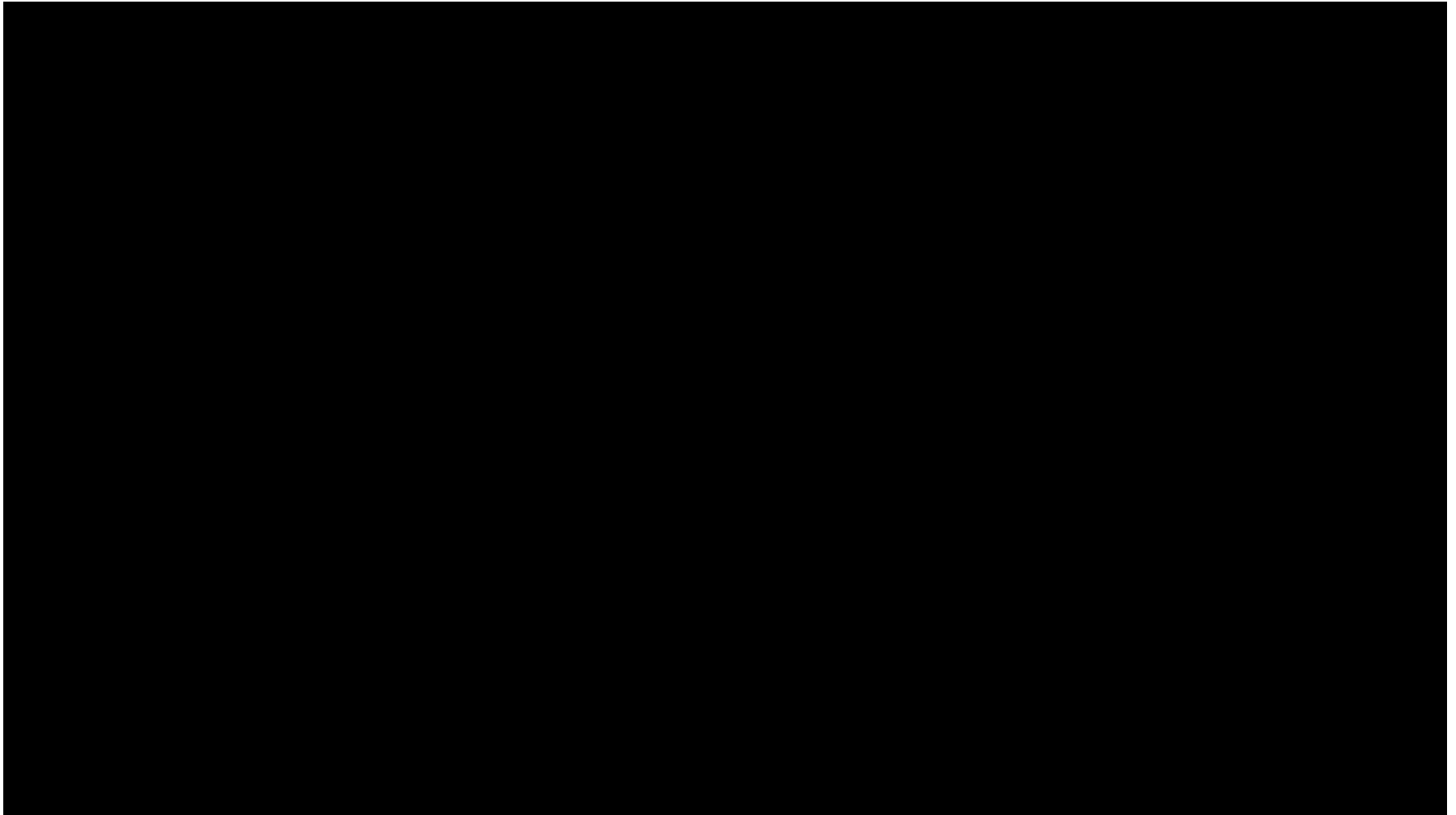

# TSC Eligibility Requirements

- Young adults (18-25)
- Must live in St.Louis Metropolitan area.
- Eager to learn and pursue a career in Technology.
- Must have high school diploma or equivalent (GED).
- Must be eligible to work in United States.
- Currently under employed or under employed with a desire to change your career path.

- ❑ 22 week, intensive IT training program.
  - ❑ 15 weeks of Training Classes
    - ❑ Monday-Friday 9:00am-1:00pm
    - ❑ Harris Stowe State University
  - ❑ 7 week paid internship program
    - ❑ 32 hours Monday–Thursday at Internship Site
    - ❑ Friday’s 9am-1:00pm Professional Development Workshop
    - ❑ Potential Internship Sites: World Wide Technology, KPMG, Emerson
- ❑ Earn a CompTIA A+ certification.
- ❑ Learn from senior IT industry executives.
- ❑ Class starts January 23, 2017.
