Attainment Gap by Race

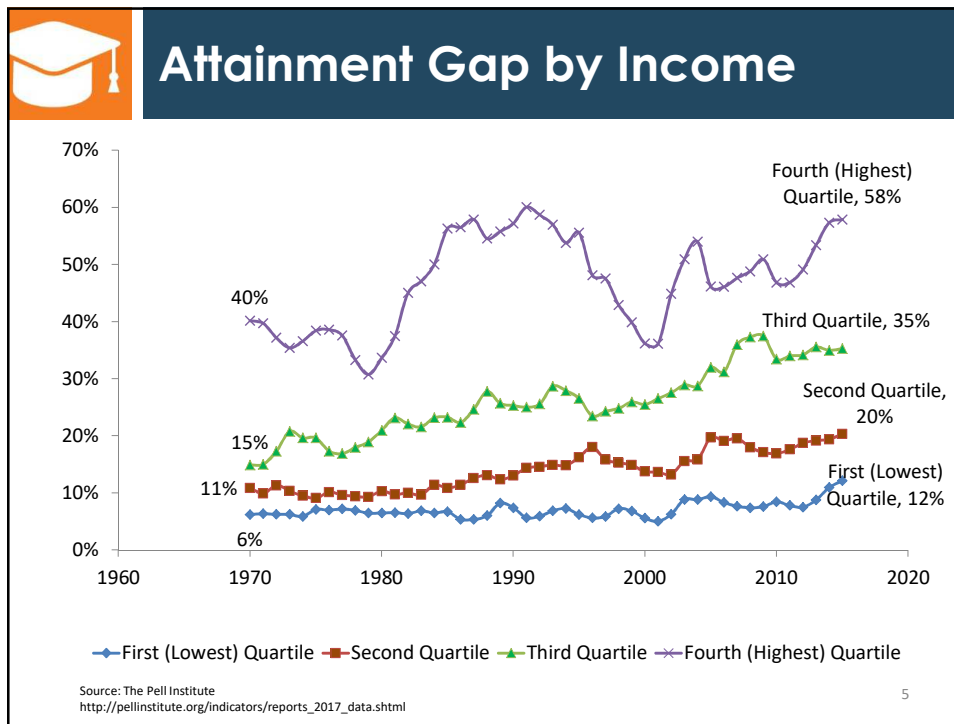
Goal: 60% of adults with AA or BA by 2025
