Job Corps Scholars Program Partnership is a tuition-free training and education program that connects eligible individuals with the skills and educational opportunities they need to establish real careers. Job Corps Scholars grant is made available through a U.S. Department of Labor grant and partnership between Covenant House Missouri and St. Louis Community College.

In addition to the educational component of the program, you may be eligible to receive career counseling, employment counseling and up to 12 months support after separation from the program. Upon completion of the program, on-the-job training through an appropriate employer or connection to an appropriate training program is made available.

CRITERIA

If you're a 16- to 24-years old St. Louis City or St. Louis County resident who's ready to work toward a successful future, contact us today to learn more about opportunities available through the Job Corps Scholars program at St. Louis Community College.

You may be eligible if you meet one or more of the following conditions:

- You receive public assistance.
- You meet the income guidelines.
- You are experiencing homelessness.
- You are a foster care recipient.

Other criteria may apply. Program staff members will help you determine your eligibility.
